Vitae et scientia aims to present, analyze and discuss the current state of public health and its component disciplines, from a multi and interdisciplinary approach"

I. Journal content:

a) **Original papers:** any article that had not been published in any magazine, platform or format.

b) **Technical reports:** any document to present an exhibition of detailed observations of the status of a particular subject related to public health issues.

c) **Conference papers:** papers officially accepted by conference organizers, its content must be original, not fully published in the official congress, symposium and / or seminar records.

d) **Presentation of clinical cases:** any work that presents the experience of diagnosis and treatment to individual patients or groups of patients around a single diagnosis or clinical problem.

Articles are due by September 16, 2011 and must be presented according to the editorial standards presented below.

Papers submitted will be reviewed by subject specialists (anonymous external evaluators) and the Editorial Board of the journal.

II. Articles should be no longer than 15 pages including all sections of the manuscript. The articles must be submitted in letter-size sheet format. It four margins must be of 3 cm.

1. Must be submitted in Times New Roman fountain No. 10.

2. Must be submitted in single-spacing.

3. Indentation will be not used, either in the text or in the cited references. The formal order will be left of the layout of the magazine.

III. Sections of the manuscript title, author (s), summary and abstract, text, references, figures and tables.

Title in English.

All submitted papers would be translated from English into Spanish

Author (s): in a footnote should state: institutional affiliation (if any), postal mail, email, at least for the first author.

It must include abstract of no more than 150 words and keywords (up to five)

Text: Main subtitles will be accepted only preceded by Roman numerals

Acknowledgments will be accepted as subsequent paragraph to the main text preceded by the word ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS (in capital letters). Funding of the research must be referenced in this section and not in footnotes page.

Capital letters will be used only for proper names.

The use of italics is for the case of quotations from historical sources, documentaries, scientific names and foreign words into English.

IV. Elements:

1. Author of article: Family name and first name
2. Year of publication (in brackets)
3. Article Title
4. Title of journal (in italics, followed by colon)
5. Volume (followed by colon)
6. Number
7. Page (separated by a hyphen)

Example:

Prieto, A. (2001). Assessment tool for teaching nurse in clinical fields(ECCE). *Horizon Nursing*, 12 (1), 11 to 21.

Note: For units with independent paging, the ones starting at page 1 starting in the Page 1, place the copy number after the volume and between brackets
Initiation

Journal article with more than one author

Elements:

1. Author, Author, Author: Family name and first name initial
2. Year of publication (in brackets)
3. Article Title
4. Title of journal (italics) (followed by a comma)
5. Volume (followed by a comma)
6. Number
7. Page (separated by a hyphen)

Example:

Kernis, MH, Cornell, DP, Sun, CR, Berry, A., & Harlow, T. (1993). There's more to self-esteem

Than it is whether high or low: The Importance of Stability of self-esteem. Journal of Personality and Social Psychology, 65 (6), 1190-1204.

Note: If an item has more than 6 authors, scoring the first 6 (author's family name, followed by the first letter) and then add et al.

Example:

Wolchik, SA, West, SG, Sandler, IN, Tein, J., Coatsworth, D., Lengua, L., et al. (2000). An experimental evaluation of theory-based mother-child programs for children of divorce. Journal of Consulting and Clinical Psychology, 68, 843-856.

V. Charts, graphs and tables.

Charts, graphs and photographs should be included at the end of the text (in a new page) and supported in separate files.

Its size should not exceed pre-set margins.

All illustrations are black and white.

Its numbers in the text consecutively with Arabic numerals in the manner shown in the text are shown in parentheses and in lowercase.

The formats should be high quality, preferably TIFF

The graphics can be sent in excel format 6.0 (or higher) and also be considered as figures.

Tables should be simple and display summary information (to be included in a new page).

All entries will be received at the electronic address (include postage)
